HOLY PLASTIC POLLUTION! OUR 2019 RIVER CLEANUPS SAVED THE DAY!

RIVERS ALIVE ORGANIZERS AND VOLUNTEERS DID IT AGAIN. THEY CAME TOGETHER IN THEIR COMMUNITIES AND CLEANED UP OVER 1,200 MILES OF GEORGIA'S WATERWAYS IN 2019. THE DEDICATION AND COMMITMENT OF OUR PARTICIPANTS CONTINUES TO INSPIRE AND MOTIVATE ME. OUR STATEWIDE RIVER CLEANUP PROGRAM IS NOW IN ITS 22ND YEAR. MANY OF OUR CURRENT ORGANIZERS AND VOLUNTEERS GREW UP HELPING WITH CLEANUPS IN THEIR HOMETOWNS AND CONTINUE TO GIVE THEIR TIME AND ENERGY TO PROTECTING LOCAL WATERWAYS.

THIS IMPORTANT WORK NEVER ENDS. TRASH AND DEBRIS CONTINUE TO ACCUMULATE IN OUR CREEKS AND RIVERS AND, SLOWLY OVER TIME, FLOW DOWNSTREAM TO OUR OCEANS. PLASTIC BOTTLES, BAGS, AND PACKAGING FLOAT IN THE WATER AND BREAK DOWN INTO MICROPLASTICS WHICH ARE INGESTED BY AQUATIC ANIMALS AND BECOME PART OF THE FOOD CHAIN. IT IS IMPORTANT THAT WE BRING OUR CHILDREN TO RIVERS ALIVE CLEANUPS SO THEY CAN LEARN TO LOVE AND PROTECT THEIR LOCAL WATERS AND CARRY ON THIS VITAL NECESSARY TRADITION. SO THEY CAN SEE WHERE TRASH ENDS UP IF NOT RECYCLED AND DISPOSED OF PROPERLY. SO THEY TOO CAN INFLUENCE OTHERS TO CHANGE BAD HABITS AND BECOME PART OF THE SOLUTION, NOT THE PROBLEM.


## EVENT GOORDINATON & OUTRENT!



# CITE SPUTLICHT CITE OF ALPHARETTA AND ALPHARETTA MATURAL RESOURCES COMMISSION

ON AN EARLY SEPTEMBER MORNING, THE CITY OF ALPHARETTA AND ALPHARETTA NATURAL RESOURCES COMMISSION HOSTED THEIR 31<sup>ST</sup> ANNUAL CLEANUP EVENT, ALPHARETTA RIVERS ALIVE. 142 VOLUNTEERS ASSEMBLED AT ROCK MILL PARK TO REMOVE LITTER AND DEBRIS. THROUGHOUT THE COURSE OF FOUR HOURS, 2,000 POUNDS OF DEBRIS WERE REMOVED FROM THREE WETLAND AREAS, TWO BIORETENTION AREAS AND SIX MILES OF ROADWAYS. VOLUNTEER EFFORTS INCLUDED LITTER PICKUP, NATIVE PLANTINGS, STORM DRAIN STENCIUNG, AND DISTRIBUTING OUTREACH DOOR HANGERS HIGHLIGHTING THE IMPORTANCE OF PICKING UP PET WASTE.

REFLECTING ON 2019, THE CLEANUP SEASON PROVED TO BE SUCCESSFUL ONCE AGAIN. RIVERS ALIVE SAW AN INCREASED TURNOUT OF VOLUNTEERS AND NUMBER OF CLEANUP EVENTS THROUGHOUT THE STATE. WITH MORE BOOTS ON THE GROUND, MORE TRASH AND DEBRIS WERE REMOVED FROM 1,294 MILES OF WATERWAYS - AN IMPRESSIVE 534,499 POUNDS! WE ARE CERTAIN THAT NONE OF THIS WOULD HAVE BEEN ACHIEVED WITHOUT THE HARD WORK AND DEDICATION OF VOLUNTEERS AND ORGANIZERS THAT PUT FORTH THIS EFFORT, AND THE SPONSORS THAT HELPED SUPPORT CLEANUPS.
